

## News in Hardware

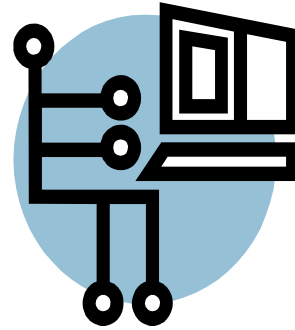

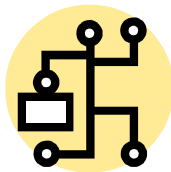
